

WONT RECOGNIZE JENKINS.

Lawyer Semple Declines to Accept a Notice in the Lambert Case.

Prosecutor Jenkins, of Camden, served notice yesterday on Lawyer John L. Semple that on March 4 he would move to have the appeal before the United States Supreme Court in the case of Murderer Theodore Lambert dismissed on the ground that it was improvidently issued.

Lawyer Semple declined to recognize the notice on the ground that Prosecutor Jenkins is not a practitioner at the bar of the United States Supreme Court.
