

KAIRER'S CREDITORS GET CASH.

Their Claims to Be Paid Out of the Murdered Baker's Estate.

A partial decision in the suit over the disposition of William G. Kairer's estate was rendered by Vice-Chancellor Pitney in Camden yesterday. Kairer was a fairly well-to-do baker, who was murdered by Burglar "Dory" Lambert a year ago. Zimri West and other creditors, who held judgments against the deceased, claimed that he had disposed of his property to his son to evade payment of his debts.

The Vice-Chancellor decided that this allegation was sustained and that the judgment creditors' claims, amounting to about \$1500, should be paid out of the estate. Decision was reserved on the question of dividing the remainder among the children of Kairer's two wives.
