

Mrs. Horkheimer Gets \$1,500 Verdict.

MAYS LANDING, N. J., May 18.— Mrs. Benjamin Horkheimer won a verdict of \$1,500 today before Judge Howard Carrow in her suit against the executors of the estate of the late Morris Horkheimer, a wealthy Philadelphia manufacturer. She sued for \$5,000, the bequest left to her late husband. The defense endeavored to show that the amount had been paid by the executors. One of the defendants was Edmund Horkheimer, head of a film company in California, who was co-executor with Mrs. Cecelia Horkheimer of Atlantic City.
